




Getting the Most from Your Fungicide

Early Detection / Program Approach

- Apply Revolution monthly at 6oz/1000 starting at the beginning of the season.
- When fairy ring symptoms appear apply fungicide plus Revolution (6oz/1000)
- Continue applying Revolution monthly for your wetting agent program
- Apply additional fungicide as necessary timed with Revolution program

Mid-Season Detection

- Begin applying fungicide and Revolution (6 oz/1000)
- Continue timed fungicide applications in conjunction with a monthly application of Revolution (6 oz/1000)
- Apply a supplemental 6-8 oz/ 1000 application of Aqueduct 1 to 2 weeks after initial Revolution + Fungicide application to aid in the suppression of the symptoms and reduce water repellency of the rings

One-Time Treatment

- Apply fungicide with Aqueduct at 8oz/1000 when symptoms appear
- Re-apply as needed
